NOAA Coastal Storms Initiative – Risk and Vulnerability Assessment Tool

Brevard County participated in a pilot program of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to create this on-line resource. This interactive mapping tool allows users to research a property, area or vicinity and assess risks from natural hazards (storm surge, flood, wind, erosion) and various man made hazards, such as proximity to hazardous material storage facilities. FEMA-defined Special Flood Hazard Areas and aerial photographs may be displayed and overlaid. The tool also contains a wealth of information for planning purposes, such as local demographics, societal factors, locations of critical facilities and environmental features.

National Weather Service - Melbourne

In addition to the latest local conditions and Doppler weather radar, this site provides on-line access to the Hurricane Storm Tide Atlas for East Central Florida. Maps may be displayed for different reaches of the Atlantic coast for Volusia, Brevard, Indian River, St. Lucie and Martin counties. Based on detailed computer modeling, these maps show areas that would be inundated by Category 1, 3 and 5 hurricanes. The Brevard County section features a link to the History Tide Points shown on the maps, listing the highest recorded surge levels at specific measurement stations throughout the County.

USGS Water Resources River Gage Stations – St. Johns River

The United States Geological Survey provides on-line access to river gage stations along the St. Johns River pertinent to Brevard County. These sites provide real-time data on river levels and flow rates, as well as historical data, to allow users within the St. Johns basin to make informed decisions on flooding threats at any given time.
